## Best Practices for a consistent video stream.

1. Try to have a hard connection to your modem. This requires an internet cable you can easily acquire from Office Depot, Target or Best Buy. Most modems will have 4 available ports.

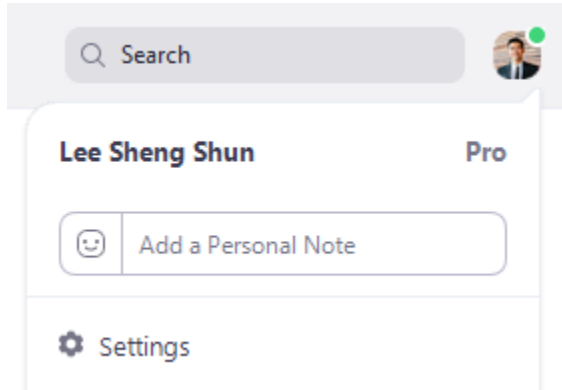


2. Keep as many programs and internet tabs closed. Only have open what you need.

## For Windows, Mac and Chromebook

### Test your video before a meeting

1. Log in to the Zoom client.
2. Click your profile picture then click **Settings**.



3. Click the **Video** tab.

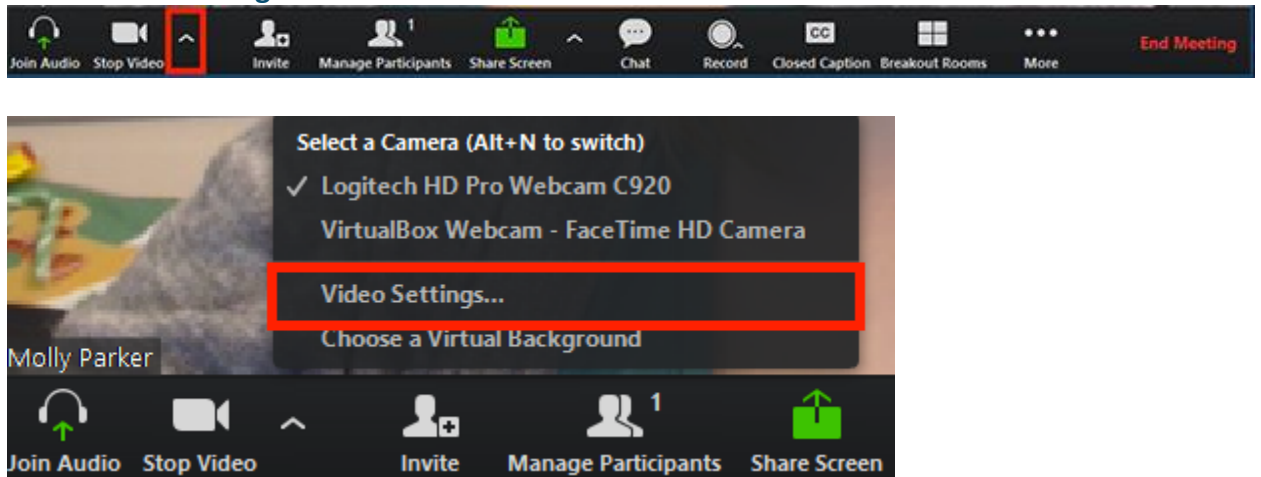


4. You will see a preview of your camera and can choose a different camera if needed.



### Testing your video while in a meeting

1. Click the arrow next to **Start Video / Stop Video**.
2. Select **Video Settings**.



Zoom will display your camera's video and [settings](#).

3. If you don't see your camera's video, click the drop-down menu and select another camera.

#### **Chromebook:**

1. Finding the settings
2. Open your Chromebook settings by clicking the gear icon in the system tray.
3. Open the Privacy and security section.
4. Click Site settings and you'll see a list of individual things that can be changed.
5. Scroll down the list to find Camera or Microphone.
